England only recycles around **44% of our waste**

In 2020, England generated **53.6 million tonnes** of non-hazardous construction and demolition waste, of which **50.0 million tonnes** was recovered



In 2020, the waste generated from commercial and industrial sectors was around **33.8 million tonnes**

Due to this, alongside waste from households, landfill sites are filling up fast and **landfill taxes are increasing**, making it more expensive to get rid of your waste this way



Recycling helps to **reduce pollution** from waste in land fill sites



Using recycled rather than raw materials in products **saves energy and costs**, and contributes to a beneficial circular economy
