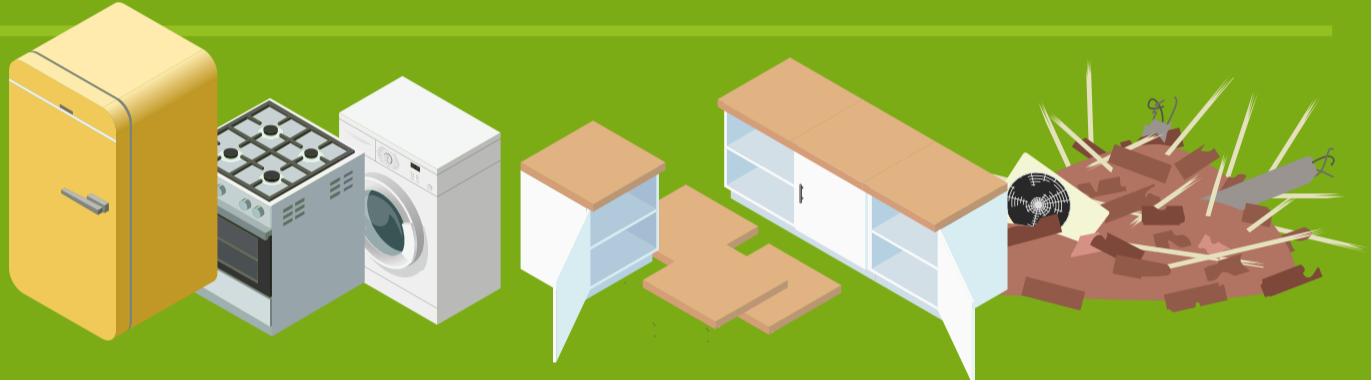
Maximising Recycling
