## Recycling Bin:

- Cardboard boxes
- Metal sweets tins

## General Rubbish Bin:

- Foil and plastic food trays
- Waste food (if you have no food waste bin)
- Shiny or glittery wrapping paper
- Plastic sweets tins



## Recycling Centres:

- Christmas trees
- Broken Christmas lights
- Aluminium foil
- Batteries

## Charity Shops and Clothing banks:

- Old clothing in good condition
- Any toys in good condition
- Any unwanted decorations or gifts
